(d) Then Student has to select Revaluation option. (e) Then, the paper code details will be displayed. Student has to select the number of papers for Revaluation. (f) Then click the calculate option, then click the make the payment option. (g) Now the student can pay the prescribed fee by Credit/Debit Card on Net banking. (h) After successful payment receipt will be generated. (i) After generating the receipt, student will get SMS and email for the receipt details.

2. There is no challenge valuation for P.G. Courses.

3. There is no provision for Photocopy of answer script.

4. Fees once paid for the Revaluation will not be refunded or adjusted for future Examinations.
